Friday, August 11

Concert 50/50 Ticket Sales – 6:45-9 pm – 3 workers

Responsibilities: sale of tickets while circulating concert grounds amongst crowd, including making change

Concert Concessions – 6:45 pm-end of concert (approximately 10 pm) – 5 workers needed

Responsibilities: sale of food items (no food preparation required), merchandise, including working with cash

Saturday, August 12

Flea Market Worker – 8-11 am at 1905 Route 3 (across road from Cenotaph) – 2 workers

Responsibilities: taking cash from sales, help with cleanup at end of sale

Fair Ground Gate Attendants – 1.5 hour shifts (times of 10 am, 11:30 am and 1 pm) – 12 workers

Responsibilities: taking cash from ticket sales, ensuring those entering have purchases tickets

Carnival Game Workers – 1.5 hour shifts (times of 11 am and 12:30 pm) – 10 workers per shift

Responsibilities: administering carnival game, including providing tickets for prize winners

Supper Server – 3:15-6:30 pm at HMCC Gymnasium – 20 servers (can do shorter shift)

Responsibilities: seating of customers, serving of food, cleaning off tables

Supper Kitchen Clean Up – 6:30-7:30 pm at HMCC Gymnasium Kitchen – 5 workers

Responsibilities: assist with clean-up of kitchen, including cleaning dishes, bowls

Sunday, August 13

Triathlon Bike or Run Volunteer – 8-11 am – 30 volunteers

Responsibilities: directing competitors on bike or race route

Triathlon Take Down Crew at Taylor Field – 12-1 pm – 8 volunteers

Responsibilities: Put away of various items used for triathlon into storage trailer
