

VILLAGE OF HARVEY

Revised By-Laws of the Village of Harvey, 1980

BY-LAW 82-6

A BY-LAW RESPECTING LOITERING, BEGGING, AND SOLICITING

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Harvey as follows:

1. Section 91.1 of the Municipalities Act, c.34, R.S.N.B., 973, which is reproduced in Schedule "A" attached hereto, is in force in the Village of Harvey.
2. This By-Law comes into effect on the date of final passing thereof.

This By-Law consolidated as of November 19, 1996.

This original By-Law being Chapter 10 is to be filed at the Harvey Village Office under By-Laws in alphabetical order.

SCHEDULE "A"

91.1 (1) -

No person shall loiter unless such person, when required to do so, justifies his reason for doing so.

91.1 (2) -

No person shall beg or solicit from door to door or in a public place except as may be authorized by the municipality.

91.1 (3) -

Every person who commits an offense under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars and in default of payment is liable to imprisonment in accordance with subsection 31(3) of the summary Convictions Act. 1977, c.35, s.3.

91.2 –

Section 91.1 shall be in force in every municipality that by By-Law adopts that section as being in force in that municipality and every municipality has the authority to make such By-Law. 1977, c.35, s.3.
